McNaughton gave the report that she and Danny Moses had received notice from Frankfort that the LEPC would be awarded \$1157.48 this year. This is the first time in a few years that Whitley County has been eligible for the grant money.</p> <p>The committee discussed the need to have maps of all utilities in the county mapped according to service area. When the maps are completed, they will be placed in the following offices: Whitley Co. Judge Executive, Whitley County Emergency Management, Mayor of Corbin, Mayor of Williamsburg and Whitley Dispatch.</p> <p>The committee discussed the need for a Shelter Committee to discuss issues in regards to shelters. Volunteers were requested to work on sheltering issues and report back to the committee at a later date. The Whitley County Health Department will be working on criteria for Special Needs Shelters and the committee will work on the general areas of the shelter.
